















School attendance at infant-toddler age (0-3) in Reggio Emilia



A service of the Municipality that deals with the right to education from 6 to 14 years old.


UNIVERSITY OF MODENA AND REGGIO EMILIA: A NETWORK UNIVERSITY

According to the AlmaLaurea Consortium Report 2019 on employment and profile of Unimore graduates:

- 67% of them get the degree within the regular time, when the national average is barely 53.6%;
- 77.8% out of the total of students taking up internships when studying (and 52.2% after university);
- The **unemployment rate** of graduates 1 year after graduation is equal to **10%** against the national average of **20.5%**.








REGGIANE INNOVATION PARK
